

59. Jüriööjooks Relay

21.04.2018 in Tartu

Jüriööjooks is an annual nightly relay orienteering race. Participating teams consist of five members with three male and two female members, ordered M-F-M-F-M. In addition to the main race, open race with three shorter stages will also take place.

Competition commemorates the Jüriöö Uprising of 1343.

TIME SCHEDULE / AGENDA:

EVENT CENTER

Event center is located at Raekoja square at the center of Tartu.

RACE REGULATIONS

Jüriööjooks is a relay race, where one participant can take part in only one stage. The winning team is the fastest team to complete the course, following the regulations. Start will be closed 30 minutes after the finish of the winner of main class (five minutes after the closing of start, mass start will be given to all remaining team members). Finish will be closed two hours after the aforementioned mass start.

COMPETITORS

All orienteering unions / associations can participate with an unlimited number of teams. Juniors under 14 (born 2004 and later) can participate with the written consent of their parent or coach. The team representative presents the written consent to the secretariat (information tent) before receiving the competition materials. The teams of EOF member clubs must consist of the members of that club.

RUNNERS BANK

The organizers of Jüriööjooks have opened a database to help find teammates for the event. Participants looking for a team can register [here](#). Team looking for members can look for the list [here](#). After having found a team, please notify the organizers.

COURSES AND CLASSES

There are two courses: Main course and Open course.

Main Course: Relay of teams with 5 members, of which at least two have to be women. The obligatory running order is M-F-M-F-M. There are no drink stations on the courses.

Different classes on the main course are:

- * Main class: all teams registered for the main course
- * Juniors: the maximum age of the competitors in the team is 18 (born 1999 or later)
- * Veterans: the sum of the age of all competitors in the team must be at least 220 years and no single competitor must be younger than 40 years (born 1977 or earlier). The sum of ages is calculated based on the year of birth.

Open Course: Relay of teams consisting of 3 competitors, the gender of the competitors is free. The first leg is the same as in the main course, other two legs are shorter.

PUNCHING SYSTEM

SPORTident - electronic SPORTident punching system is used. Every member is responsible for the punch. Double check your SI card number in the registered teams list and notify the organizers of any changes at once. One SI card may be used several times by one team (not consecutively).

RESTRICTED AREAS

Restricted areas come to power starting from competition day. Full information at the event center!

FAIR PLAY

Every participant agrees to the competition manual and with the rules of fair play. Fair play includes not entering restricted areas, also not investigating old maps of the terrain.

RACE NUMBERS

Running with the race number is mandatory. Teams receive race numbers from the event center starting from 18.00 on the race day. NB! All legs will receive BOTH front and back race numbers, which have to be visible during the race. For recycling purposes, please bring your own safety pins for the race number.

REMEMBER!

The terrain is open for traffic (cars, bicycles) and pedestrians; all competitors are responsible for their own safety.

Be aware of traffic when crossing the streets. Cobblestones and stairs might be slippery.

CLOTHING AND SHOES

Dress according to weather. Organizers recommend to use shoes with good grip on all terrains. **Shoes with metal spikes are not allowed!**

ORDER FOR THE RELAY AREA

Relay changeover will be in the event center.

Participants waiting for the changeover must enter the start area, where SI card numbers and race numbers are checked and GPS devices are given to the predetermined teams.

Participants coming from the leg must cross the finish line and punch finish SI station. Race map must be handed to the organizer! Participant then runs to the start area for the next member to start the leg. Next participant must go to the wall of maps and receive the map allocated to their team and proceed to check points. Participants, who have finished go to the IT tent for results, read their data, and receive the result slip.

GPS - TRACKING

GPS-trackers will be given to twenty teams determined by the organizers. Using the GPS-trackers is mandatory if assigned.

SCREENING AT THE COMPETITION CENTER

There will be a big screen for live stream of the competition. Several cameras placed on the terrain produce a live video of the competition. In addition GPS-tracking results and radio checkpoint feeds are available.

FIRST AID

Med point is open at the event center.

OTHER INFO

- Dressing rooms with showers are available near the event center. More info in the competition manual.

- Bags can be left in the information tent.
- Parking in Tartu is for free on weekends.

AWARDS

The winning team of main course will be awarded with the travelling prize “Kalevipoeg Throwing a Stone”. Each member of the winning team receives a smaller glass copy of the travelling prize. If the winning team comes from outside Estonia, the travelling prize will remain in the Estonian Sports Union “Jõud” until next year’s competition. Three best teams will be awarded in the main class. The best teams in classes junior, senior, and open class will receive a prize. Special prizes will be given for the first finisher of each leg.

REGISTRATION

Registering takes place on <https://osport.ee/> until **April 16th** (included). Team is considered as registered after the registration is complete and participation fees are paid.

Teams must provide names of team members, SI-numbers or rental requests and leg order by **17:00, April 20th**. It is mandatory to provide the birth year of the team members. SI-card rental fee is 2€.

COMPLAINTS AND PROTESTS

Complaints must be addressed in a written form to the information tent of the event, no later than 15 minutes after the publication of the last results. Complaints will be investigated and the decision will be revealed to the plaintiff as soon as possible.

Protests can be filed for the decision of organizers. Protests must be given in a written form to the EOL representative or a jury member, no later than one hour after the organizers decision was revealed. Complaints and protests are free of charge.
