



Rogain is a team orienteering competition where the aim is to collect as many points as possible while visiting as many control points spread across the terrain as possible during the given time frame.

The amount of points received from a single control point differs by the location and accessibility of the control point. The order of visiting control points is not marked which means every team chooses its own route. There is no minimum amount set for control points to be taken - every team chooses the route and amount of control points according to their skills.

STIHL x Seiklushunt rogain series 2023 (time and place):

- 1. Valga-Valka rogain, 1st of April
- 2. Järvselja rogain, 10th of June (Tartu county)
- 3. Narva-Jõesuu rogain, 26 of August
- 4. Kääriku rogain, 22nd of October (Near Otepää)

At the beginning of the competition week, the additional information about every individual rogain event will be added.

Timetable:

Showers and catering:

There is a showering/changing facility in the competition center.

There will be hot meal and a bottle of water for the participants after the finish.

Classes, conditions, check time:

Teams of 2-5 members can participate. Control time for the main class is 4 hours, for the bicycle class 3 hours and for the family class 2 hours.

Prizes:

The three best teams of every class (MM, NN, and MN) will be awarded. In other classes, only the winners will be awarded except in family class where lottery prizes will be given.

The winner of the whole series will be determined by adding ranking points from all the individual events. Records are kept based on team name and following three important rules:

1. Team name must be the same in all separate events.

2. At least one team member must be the same as in the last event!

3. Event class must be the same in all events!

Punching system:

SPORTident punching system will be used in every class. SPORTident card can be rented from the organizers (2 \in). In family class, the SPORTident rent will cost 1 \in .

All participants must attach the SPORTident device with a non-removable wristband. Wristband will be given from organizers with other competition materials. In family class, only one member must attach the SPORTident device with a non-removable wristband. All members of a team must visit the control point for the team to receive points of that control point within 60 seconds, starting from registering the first SPORTident device of the team. As there are more than 30 control points on the terrain, SI-cards with capacity for at least 50 entries are needed. This means SPORTident devices with numbers 1 - 499 999 and 2 000 000 - 2 999 999 cannot be used. Capacity protests will not be upheld later.

Notice! The finishing time for each competitor will be marked when the very last registration with the SPORTident at finish station is done.

Competition rules:

- The aim of the competition is to collect as many points as possible while visiting as many control points spread across the terrain as possible. It can be done either on foot or by bicycle within the given time period.
- The amount of points for a checkpoint differs by difficulty and distance (from 2 to 5) according to the first digit of the control point number (e.g. control point 47 gives 4 points). The amount and order of the control points collected is free to choose by the team.
- Competition materials include bib-numbers, protective firm for the map, wristbands to attach the SPORTident devices one per team member.
- The wristband must remain intact and around the wrist when it gets to the finish.
- In the main class, the course is open for 4 hours, in the "bicycle" class the course is open 3 hours and in the "family" class the control time is 2 hours. Exceeding the control time results in a penalty of -1 point for every minute exceeded (e.g finishing the bicycle class with 3:00:34 time gives a penalty of -1 point). Exceeding the check time for more than 15 minutes results in disqualification.
- The points collected after deducting the penalties will determine final ranking. With the same amount of points, the faster team ranks higher. Finish time of the team will be calculated after the last participant of the team has registered the SPORTident device.
- During the competition (from the start until the finish), all participants must wear the bib-numbers visible. If one or more members of the team wish to discontinue the competition, the team must return to finish and the whole

team must end the competition. Only maps handed out by the organizers may be used during the competition with the help of a compass and a wristwatch.

- The use of other navigation devices and programmable devices is prohibited and will result in disqualification.
- Areas streaked in red or olive green on the map are prohibited to enter by all the participants. These are private areas, please respect the privacy.

Registration and participation fees:

In the main and in the "bicycle" class fees are per participant.

In the class "family", the fee is per team.

First round of registration is $19\mathbb{C}$, second round is $25\mathbb{C}$ and during the competition week and on the event day the registration fee is $30\mathbb{C}$.

Rent of the SPORTident is 2€, for family class it is 1€.

To register for all three events at once, the fee is 60€ (valid until 1st of March).

Violating the rules and protests:

Breaking the rules of the competition: If a referee registers the team entering a prohibited area, the team will be disqualified.

Dangers:

There is traffic on the city streets. All participants must obey all the traffic rules during the competition (i.e. traffic lights), and are solely responsible for their well-being.

By making a registration and paying the entry fee, the participant is agrees

... with the instructions, rogaine general guide and conditions set by the organizer;

- ... that his/her personal data is used in accordance with Estonian laws and regulations;
- ... that the organizer will send information emails;
- ... that he/she is well trained and healthy to participate in the sport event.

Rights of the organizer

-The organizer has the right to make changes in the additional information that will be available at the beginning of the competition week.

-The organizer has the right to disqualify any participants who do not follow the instructions and regulations of the competition.

-The organizer has the right to use photos and videos taken during the event for its promotional use.

-If the event is cancelled due to conditions not caused by the organizer (Force Majeure), the participation fees will not be refunded.

-If a registered person is not present, the participation fee will not be refunded.

Questions which cannot be solved based on this guide will be resolved on an ongoing basis by the organizer.
